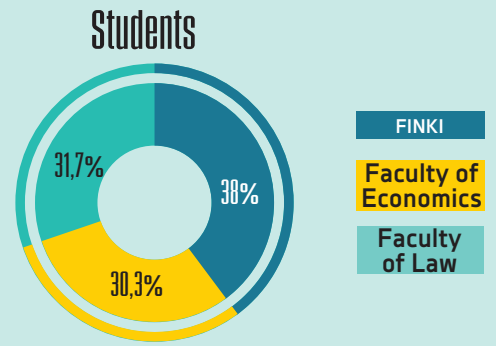


# Introduction to student practice

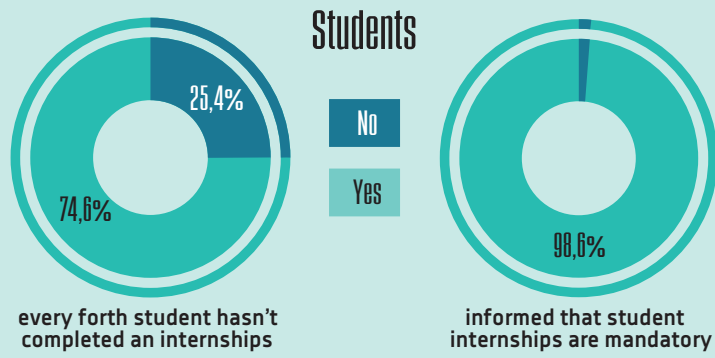

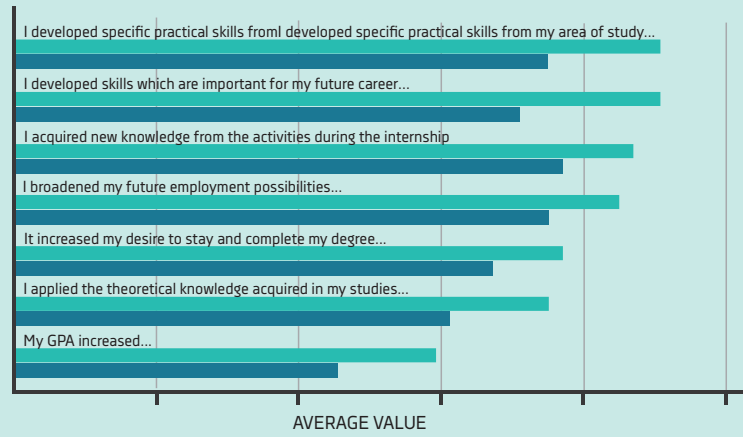
In 2010, student internships became mandatory for all students who have completed their first year of studies. Student internships are regulated by the Rules on the manner of organizing practical training for students, a legal document by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Macedonia.

We believe that these statistics are due to the prevailing dissatisfaction among students.

Student internships do not meet the expectations of students and students can't recognize the link between theoretical knowledge acquired at the university and its application in the "real world".

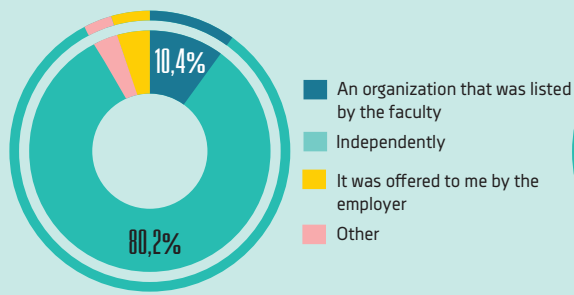


Despite the fact, that almost every student is aware of its mandatory nature



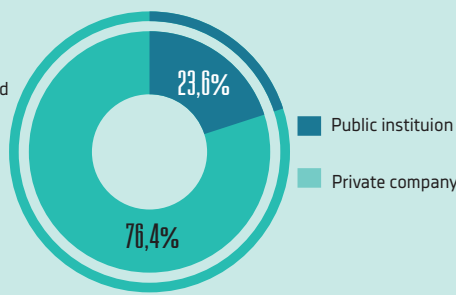
## Faculties insufficiently inform their students about the potential opportunities for student internships.

The majority of students completed their internship in a private company

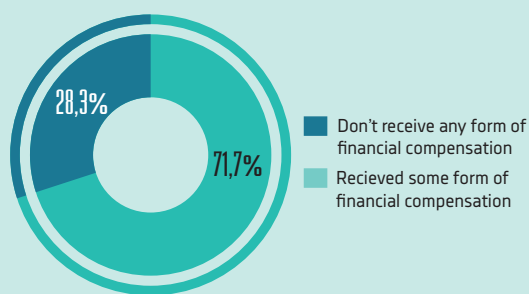
The type of institution in which the internships was completed



This is primarily due to the fact that private companies are more available and offer greater opportunity for future employment for students.

Students believe they should be financially compensated for their work.

Because currently this is not the case

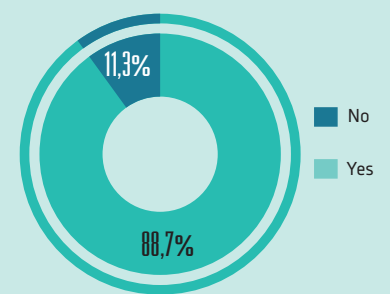


This is not the case for students of the Faculty of Computer Science and Engineering where 53.85% of students reported that they received financial compensation for the tasks they performed during practice.

Two out of the nine companies that were interviewed saw no reason why interns should receive financial compensation.

Despite these problems students believe that student practice should maintain its mandatory status

Should student internships be mandatory?

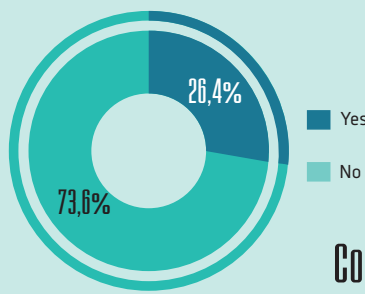


None of the faculties covered in this study have established specific criteria based on which a company is assessed as suitable for the completion of student practice.

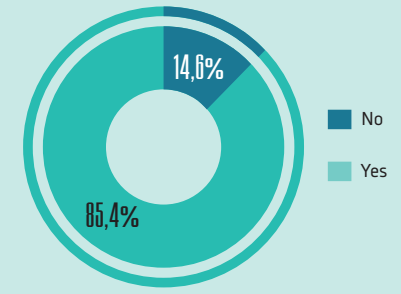
Only the Faculty of Computer Science and Engineering keeps a complete record of students who completed their internship. Such systems are completely absent in the "Iustinianus Primus" Faculty of Law.

The majority of students didn't have a mentor from their higher education institution available to them.

## Companies

All of the companies that were interviewed claimed they have a mentor available for their interns. This is also confirmed by the students
